### 5. Attachments to the Form

#### 5.1. Documents required for calculating child support

When calculating the amount of child support, you should have the following documents with you, as applicable:

#### Parent's Financial Situation

- Net income of the parent
  - Current year's income statement (e.g. pay slip) and previous year's full income (latest confirmed tax decision). The documentation must show holiday pay, benefits and statutory withholdings.
  - Documentation of business income (income statement, balance sheet, accounting records of private transactions)
  - Documentation of pension income
  - Documentation of social benefits (e.g. unemployment allowance, Kela benefits)
  - Documentation of other income (e.g. capital income, dividends)
- Possible social assistance decision
- Proof of study duration
- Housing costs of permanent residence
  - Rent
  - Mortgage

- Maintenance charge
- Water
- Electricity
- Heating
- Home insurance
- Property tax
- Rent for plot
- Waste fee
- Chimney sweeping
- etc.
- Child visitation travel costs (in 2026 the deductible is €147/month/child)
- Other support responsibilities (other underage children)

## **7. Instructions for Completing the Form**

---

### 1. Personal Information

- 1.1. Provide the age, personal identity codes, and names of the children whose child support agreements you will be making. If there are more than four children, fill out an additional form or include the details of the additional children in the "Additional Information" section
- 1.2. Fill in your personal identity code, name, phone number, and email address
- 1.3. Provide information about the number of people living in your household.
- 1.4. Provide information about your other underage children not covered by the upcoming child support agreements.

### 2. Give permission to verify your information from the Income Register and Kela and provide information about your monthly income and expenses. Also include information about your other assets. Special healthcare costs include long-term and more-than-minor healthcare and medication expenses that are necessary due to a disability or illness.

- 2.1. Provide monthly expenses for the children covered by the upcoming child support agreements. Also include information about the child's possible income or capital/fortune. If there are more than two hobbies, you can write their details in the "Additional Information" section. The child's special healthcare costs includes long-term and more-than-minor healthcare and medication expenses that are necessary due to a disability or illness.
- 2.2. If you use public transportation for commuting, provide the monthly costs of commuting. If you use your own car, the calculation of deductible commuting costs requires the additional tax percentage from your tax card and your daily commuting distance.

### 3. Include any other information you would like the child supervisor to consider.
